He currently leads the GMC project "Doctors of the Future", and is also heavily involved with the Education Committee. He has spent the past four years reviewing the University teaching programme for medical students and operates at the Nuffield Manor Hospital in Oxford. He is a member of Council at the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, and until 2004 was Trainer in Chief for all surgical specialties in the FRCS exams throughout the UK.

Dr Victoria Hunt EdD holds a doctorate in adult education, an MSc in Medical Education, and started out her professional career as a dentist. Her main interest is in the design of training programmes, particularly looking at methods of assessment. She has been the educational advisor and has trained all examiners who sit on the Intercollegiate Boards of Surgery in the UK. She has also worked widely abroad, including Denmark, Australia, Lithuania, Africa, Egypt, Turkey and Austria, and was educational advisor to the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh until 2002.
