

Prof. Dr. Nurhan Avman

Prof. Dr. Nurhan Avman 1928 yılında Tekirdağ'da doğdu. Babası subay, annesi öğretmen olduğu için ilk ve orta öğrenimini değişik illerde yaptı. Liseyi, 1946 yılında Samsun'da bitirerek, İstanbul Tıp Fakültesi'ne girdi. 1951 yılında mezun oldu. Askerlik görevini yedek subay olarak İstanbul'da bitirdikten sonra 1954 yılında Amerika'ya giderek, 1954-1955 yılları arasında Chicago'da Dr. Thorek'in kliniğinde genel cerrahi eğitimi yaptı. 1955-1957 yılları arasında Dartmouth Medical School'da 4 yıl nöroşirürji yaptı. 1959 yılında Amerikan Nöroşirürji Board sınavını vererek, Board Sertifikası sahibi oldu. 1959-1960 yılları arasında Harvard Medical School'da research fellow ve associate profesör olarak çalıştıktan sonra Türkiye'ye döndü. 1960 yılında Hacettepe Nöroşirürji bölümünü kurdu ve 5 yıl süre ile bu bölümün direktörlüğünü yaptı. 1964 yılında doçent olan Dr. Avman 1965 yılında Ankara Üniversitesi'ne geçerek nöroşirürji kliniğini kurdu. 1969 yılında profesörlüğe yükseldi ve 19.02.1988'e kadar bölüm başkanlığına devam etti.



Ziya L. Gökaslan MD FACS

ZIYA L. GOKASLAN was born on April 07, 1959 in Washington, D.C. (USA). He later returned to Turkey with his family where he completed his medical education at the Medical Faculty of Istanbul University. In 1984, Dr. Gokaslan returned to the U.S. and worked as the Clinical Director of Sleep Disorders Center of the Department of Psychiatry for 1 ½ years. He then entered General Surgery Residency under Dr. Michael E. DeBakey in 1985. After one year of internship, he joined Department of Neurosurgery of Baylor College of Medicine as Clinical Neurotrauma Research Fellow. In 1988, he became a Neurosurgery Resident under Dr. Robert G. Grossman and completed his training at the Baylor College of Medicine in Houston in 1993. He was, then, accepted into Neurosurgery/Orthopaedic Spine Surgery Fellowship Training under Drs. Paul Cooper and Thomas Errico at the New York University Medical Center in New York. After the completion of his Fellowship Training in Spinal Surgery, Dr. Gokaslan returned to Houston and joined the faculty of Department of Neurosurgery as Assistant Professor at the University of Texas, MD Anderson Cancer Center under Dr. Raymond Sawaya. That is where Dr. Gokaslan specialized in the surgical treatment of spinal neoplasms, published extensively on the topic and developed novel surgical approaches in managing these tumors. In 2000, Dr. Gokaslan became the Director of Neurosurgical Spinal Oncology Section and, in 2002, he was appointed as Deputy Chairman of the Department of Neurosurgery and was promoted to Associate Professor. In 2002, Dr. Gokaslan was recruited to Johns Hopkins University, Department of Neurosurgery and became the Director of the Spine Division, Vice-Chairman, and Professor of Neurosurgery, Oncology, and Orthopaedic Surgery under Dr. Henry Brem. Later that year, he was awarded the Donlin M. Long Professorship at Johns Hopkins. Dr. Gokaslan's clinical practice focuses on the radical surgical treatment of both primary and metastatic spinal tumors, sacral neoplasms and spinal cord tumors. He developed many novel approaches for resection of pancost tumors, spinal neoplasms, as well as sacral tumors, including total sacrectomy and complex spinal and pelvic reconstruction. His basic research focuses on the development of new animal models to study the pathophysiology of neoplastic spinal cord compression and to define the roles of proteolytic enzymes in tumor invasion and to devise novel therapeutic approaches to spinal tumors.
